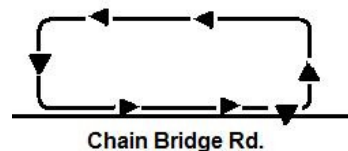

More Important Information Regarding Redeemer's Parking Lot

Lutheran Church of the Redeemer will soon begin renovating the front of the church. During construction, it will be possible to **neither drive nor walk** between the two parking lots. The parking lot on the Chain Bridge Rd. side will be modified to create a one-way circle. **There will also be a "Right Turn Only" sign posted at the exit from the Chain Bridge Parking Lot.** Please be ready for these new traffic patterns.



If you need to **get back to Westmoreland**, you might consider turning right on Chain Bridge Rd, right at the next light which is Tennyson, right on Longfellow, and right on Old Chesterbrook. This will bring you out on Westmoreland, just east of Redeemer.
